THE CLUB LOTTERY

Our Lottery, which besides making a very important, and necessary contribution to the Club's income, gives Members a chance of a little flutter for a small outlay.

The established arrangements for the Lottery are as follows:

1. **The cost for a flutter in our weekly draw is 50p and we have Summer and Winter sessions of 26 weeks each. A number is allocated, in the form of a share, at a cost, for each session, of £13, or £26 for 2 shares (Members, normally, retain the same number(s) each session).**
2. **To try to accommodate all Members, there are 150 shares in our Lottery, 1 -50 Red shares, 1-50 Green shares and 1-50 Blue shares) and every Saturday, holders of a Red, Green, or Blue share of the winning number, will each win £10, except for one week in April and October, (to coincide with the Pre-Season and End of Season meetings), when we have a 'Spring Bonanza' and an 'Autumn Bonanza', when, given all shares are taken up, the prize is £50 for each winning share.**
3. **The winning number, every Saturday, is the Health Lottery bonus ball, numbered between 1 and 50. Therefore, on any **Saturday night**, you can discover, for yourself, when you have hit the 'Jackpot', before you receive a cheque, or cash, from the Club, for your winnings! **Results** can be seen on TV Channel 5 or, on the Internet ~ www.healthlottery.co.uk/results/ .**
4. **Before the start of each Session, Shareholders are invited to continue with their flutter. New Members are given priority in the choice of any of the 150 shares that are not taken up, before they are offered to other Members.**

Our Lottery and the Law (Gambling Act 2005 applies)

We are defined as a 'Private Society Lottery' and are exempt from the need of an Operator's Licence from the Gambling Commission AND the need for registration by our Local Authority.

Qualifications:

We promote our Lottery to our Members only ('Honorary', 'Playing' and 'Non-Playing'), who are at least of 16 years of age and the whole proceeds, less prizes, are applied to the purposes of our Club.

Members' Spouses, or Partners may purchase a share.

We apply a minimum 54% of our gross proceeds directly to the purposes of our Club (min requirement = 20%), distributing a maximum 46% in Prize money (maximum requirement 80% including expenses).

We do not sell more than £20,000 of 'tickets' or make more than £250,000 pa.
